

MITTENS Version 2

*Pattern by Alexis Moore, AlexIsCrafting on Ravelry and Instagram
Intended for use by the New York City Crochet Guild*



Supplies

Red Heart Hygge Yarn 1 skein
Red Heart Hygge Fur Yarn 1 skein
(or another yarn that can be used with a K hook)
K hook (6.5 mm)

Notes

- Mitten is worked in the round after wrist section
- Feel for the stitches since they can be difficult to see when using fur yarn
- Optional adjustments include changing the number of rows for the wrist piece and shortening the mitten after skipping stitches for the thumb, as described in pattern below
- Depending on the fur yarn used, it may look better to flip the mitten inside out upon completion since the inside can end up fluffier than the outside

Wrist section/Cuff

Using Red Heart Hygge yarn

Chain 6, turn

Row 1 - 13: hdc 4, ch 1, turn (repeat for desired length for wrist)

Sl st sides together, weave in ends

Hand section

Using 2 strands of Red Heart Hygge Fur yarn

- Rnd 1: sc 18 around top of cuff, place marker before starting the next round
Rnd 2: (sc 8, sc 2 in 1) x2 [20]
Rnd 3: sc 20 [20]
Rnd 4: sc 2 in 1, sc 19 [21]
Rnd 5: sc 21 [21]
Rnd 6: sc 2 in 1, sc 20 [22]
Rnd 7: sc 22 [22]
Rnd 8: sc 2 in 1, sc 21 [23]
Rnd 9: sc 23 [23]
Rnd 10: sc 2 in 1, sc 22 [24]
Rnd 11: sc 2 in 1, sc 23 [25]
Rnd 12: ch 1, skip 7 sts, sc 8, sc2in1, sc8 [20, 7 aside for thumb]
Rnd 13 - 19: sc 20 for 8 rows [20] (repeat sc 18 for fewer rows to shorten length of mitten)
Rnd 20: (sc2tog, sc 8) x2 [18]
Rnd 21: (sc2tog, sc 7) x2 [16]
Rnd 22: (sc2tog, sc 6) x2 [14]
Rnd 23: (sc 1, sc2tog) x4 [10]
Rnd 24: (sc2tog) x4, *sew closed using tail* [5]

Thumb section

Using 2 strands of Red Heart Hygge Fur yarn

- Rnd 1: pick up stitches around gap of 7 stitches and palm area to create 11 sts and sc 11 around [11]
Rnd 2: sc 11 around [11]
Rnd 3: sc 9, sc2tog [10]
Rnd 4: sc 10 [10]
Rnd 5: sc 8, sc2tog [9]
Rnd 6: sc 7, sc2tog [8]
Rnd 7: sc 6, sc2tog [7]
Rnd 8: sc 5, sc2tog [6]
Rnd 9: (sc2tog) x3, *sew closed using tail* [3]

Abbreviations

Ch - chain stitch

Hdc - half double crochet

Rnd - round

Row - row

Sc - single crochet

Sc2in1 - single crochet 2 stitches into the same stitch to increase

Sc2tog - single crochet 2 stitches together to decrease

Sl - slip stitch
